AVIM Note: Nils Lange, a former research fellow at the Konrad-Adenauer-Stiftung in Ankara/Türkiye (an organization with which AVIM has cooperated on numerous occasions), is well acquainted with the political affairs and sensitivities of both the European Union and Türkiye. Due to his intimate knowledge of the issue at hand, the points made in Langes article are worthy of consideration.

In September 1963, the EUs predecessor organization and Turkey signed an association agreement that was meant to pave the way toward full membership for Ankara. Six decades later, frustration has replaced hope while tension mounts. Its time for a new approach.

A path to deeper economic and political integration with Europe. Closer economic ties between Turkey and the EUs predecessor body, the European Economic Community. Open doors that Turkey need only walk through: that was the basic promise of the Ankara Agreement. Today, this vision seems a long way off, and the process set in motion 60 years ago has been stalled for years.
