SIPRI: ARMS IMPORTS BY AZERBAIJAN WERE 20 TIMES HIGHER THAN THOSE OF ARMENIA IN 2012-16

The volume of international transfers of major weapons has grown continuously since 2004 and increased by 8.4 per cent between 2007 [and 2012 [according to new data on arms transfers published today by the Stockholm International Peace Research Institute (SIPRI), APA reports.
The five biggest exporters [TT] United States, Russia, China, France and Germany [TTT] accounted for 74 per cent of the total volume of arms exports.

The flow of arms increased to Asia and Oceania and the Middle East between 2007 [and 2012–16, while there was a decrease in the flow to Europe, the Americas and Africa.
Fifty countries purchased military equipment from Russia in this period. Azerbaijans arms imports from Russia made 4 per cent. The US sold military equipment and weapons to 100 countries.
Imports by Azerbaijan were 20 times higher than those of Armenia in 2012-16.
Algeria was the largest arms importer in Africa with 46 per cent of all imports to the region.
