The first meeting on the strategic dialogue on security issues between Georgia and the European Union is to take place in Tbilisi today.

Georgia is one of the most important components of Europe's security system, Georgian Prime Minister Giorgi Kvirikashvili said at a government meeting, APA's local bureau reported.

"The commencement of a high-level strategic dialogue on security issues between Georgia and the EU is a very important achievement.
