Erdogan also recalled that President Ilham Aliyev recently participated in the D-8 Summit in Istanbul as a special guest.

During the meeting of the High Level Strategic Cooperation Council, we will look into such issues and sign one protocol and some contracts which will further strengthen the legal base of our bilateral cooperation. Next year were going to host the 7th meeting and we will be honored to meet my dear brother President Ilham Aliyev in our country, he added.
