
OGAWA □ CRNADAK: ORGANIZATION OF AN INVESTMENT SEMINAR IN JAPAN PLANNED SOON

During the meeting with the Minister of Foreign Affairs of BiH, Igor Crnadak, the Ambassador of Japan to BiH Kazuya Ogawa expressed an interest in the organization of an investment seminar in Japan. It would represent an opportunity for economy subjects from Japan to meet with businessmen and institutions of BiH as well as the business opportunities of the two countries.

Crnadak assessed Ogawas initiative as a great opportunity for the establishment of a strong economic relationship between BiH and Japan.

They estimated the recent visit of Crnadak to Japan as very successful, at the meeting that was held in Banja Luka, as announced by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of BiH.
