YEREVAN, MINSK TUNED TO DEVELOPMENT OF ECONOMIC RELATIONS

Karen Karapetyan, Armenian prime minister, met Friday with his Belarusian counterpart Andrey Kobyakov in Almaty, where the two counties premiers came to attend the Eurasian Economic Unions prime-ministerial meeting.

Karapetyan and Kobyakov discussed the agenda of Armenia-Belarus economic relations and outlined cooperation development prospects.

Karapetyan said that trade turnover between the two countries grew 20% over 11 months of 2017, compared with the same period a year before.

He told Kobyakov about the free economic zone opened in November on the Armenia-Iran border in the hope that this information will attract interest of Belarusian businessmen.

The two prime ministers also spoke about cooperation inside the Eurasian Economic Union.
