
CHINA'S TOP POLITICAL ADVISOR MEETS MONTENEGRO'S PARLIAMENT SPEAKER

China's top political advisor Wang Yang met with Ivan Brajovic, speaker of the Parliament of Montenegro, on Wednesday.

Wang, chairman of the National Committee of the Chinese People's Political Consultative Conference (CPPCC), said China and Montenegro had carried out exchanges and cooperation under the guidance of mutual respect and trust, equality, mutual benefit and win-win results, making positive contribution to the world peace and development.
