During the pre-election campaign, we have made a pre-election pledge that the government makeup should be changed, the number of ministries should be reduced; we must go on that road without deviations.

The Acting Prime Minister of Armenia, Nikol Pashinyan, on Thursday stated the aforesaid at the beginning of this years first Cabinet session of the government, News.am reports.

He stressed, however, that the meaning and objective of this process is not to save money.
