
ARMENIA, ESTONIA SEE HUGE UNTAPPED ROOM FOR DEVELOPMENT OF RELATIONS

Armenian Foreign Minister Zohrab Mnatsakanyan, who is now in Tallinn for an official visit, met yesterday with President of the Riigikogu (Parliament of Estonia) Eiki Nestor, the press office of Armenias foreign ministry reports.
