The elections on December 9 of last year were the first whose results have not been contested at the Constitutional Court. So, the Government of Armenia is endowed with an unprecedented high degree of legitimacy.

Prime Minister Nikol Pashinyan on Tuesday stated the aforementioned at the National Assembly, as he presented the proposed program of the government.
