ARMENIA PARLIAMENT SPEAKER MEETS HIS MOLDOVAN COUNTERPART

Armenian parliament speaker Ararat Mirzoyan met with his Moldovan counterpart Zinaida Greceanîi and representatives of the Armenian community of Moldova, Armenian parliaments press service reported.
The sides met in the Kazakh capital Nur-Sultan. The parties highlighted the importance of friendly relations between the two countries, in the strengthening of which the parliaments play a great role.
