POLAND EVACUATES ITS AMBASSADOR FROM IRAQ

Following Iran's attack on two U.S. bases in Iraq, Poland evacuated its ambassador in Iraq, according to Polish Foreign Minister Jacek Czaputowicz, local media reported on Wednesday.

Czaputowicz told Radio ZET that Beata Peksa, the Polish ambassador to Iraq, has been evacuated and returned to Poland

It was also reported that the evacuation took place at the request of British diplomats, because the Polish embassy is located in the international zone of the British embassys premises.

Meanwhile, Slovenian Foreign Ministry announced on Twitter that it is coordinating with Germany to transfer its soldiers stationed in Iraq to a safer location, without clarifying the location.

***Later in the day, the Japanese Foreign Ministry announced that it temporarily closed its embassy in the capital Iraq following airstrikes on the U.S. bases, according to the Kyodo news agency.
