## **POLAND'S JUST TRANSITION BONUS CUT 50% UNDER LATEST EU BUDGET PROPOSAL**

Poland would see its 11 billion share of the EU's Just Transition Fund cut in half under a new EU budget proposal published on Friday (14 February), which penalises countries that have not signed up to the bloc's 2050 climate-neutrality goal.

European Council President Charles Michel's attempt at brokering an EU budget compromise includes fresh conditions for the fledgling 100 billion Just Transition Fund (JTF), which still needs to be approved by EU member states.

The European Commission unveiled the Fund last month as part of its wider Just Transition Mechanism, a 54 billion package of grants and investments that is designed to help countries enact stricter climate policies and deal with the impacts of going green.
