For more than a century the sprawling lignite mines in Australias Latrobe Valley provided the fuel that powered the southern state of Victoria.

At its peak, five coal-fired power plants burnt the soft, brown sedimentary rock □ one of the dirtiest sources of energy □ casting vast plumes of toxic smoke into the atmosphere that accounted for more than half of the states total greenhouse gas emissions.
