Azerbaijans President Ilham Aliyev held talks with Russian Deputy Prime Minister Alexei Overchuk, the co-chair of the Russia-Azerbaijan intergovernmental commission for economic cooperation, on Sunday, focusing on bilateral cooperation in 2021, the AZERTAC news agency said.
