Of the three Central Asian countries bordering Afghanistan, Uzbekistan and Tajikistan have been actively dealing with the consequences of Afghanistans fallout. While Tashkent is more in a wait-and-accept mode toward the Taliban, Dushanbe has been vocal about its opposition to the group.

Tashkents position toward the new government in Afghanistan has been to urge the formation of an inclusive government that encompasses various rivaling powers.
