CROATIAN, MONTENEGRIN PRESIDENTS ACCUSE VUCIC OF REVIVING SERBIAN NATIONALISM

The Croatian and Montenegrin presidents, Zoran Milanovic and Milo Djukanovic, on Thursday accused Belgrade of reviving the Serbian nationalism of the 1990s that plunged the region into war.

During his visit to Croatia, Djukanovic said Serbias President, Aleksandar Vucic, was reviving the retrograde political messages of the wars of the 1990s in former Yugoslavia.

Once again, the illusion is being spread that multiethnic democracy is not possible in the Western Balkans, that it is time to create enlarged nationally and religiously homogeneous states, he said.
