ALIYEV, PASHINYAN AGREE TO MEET AT EASTERN PARTNERSHIP SUMMIT IN BRUSSELS NEXT MONTH

Azerbaijans President Ilham Aliyev and Armenian Prime Minister Nikol Pashinyan have agreed to hold a meeting at the Eastern Partnership (EaP) Summit in Brussels, Belgium on December 15, 2021.

The meeting comes after European Council President Charles Michels phone conversations about the situation in the region with President Aliyev and Prime Minister Pashinyan on November 19, 2021. Michel previously discussed the border tensions between Armenia and Azerbaijan with the two leaders on November 16, when the two neighboring countries clashed in a one-day bloody battle.

President Charles Michel proposed to host President Ilham Aliyev and Prime Minister Nikol Pashinyan for a meeting in Brussels in the margins of the EaP Summit. Leaders have agreed to meet in Brussels to discuss the regional situation and ways of overcoming tensions for a prosperous and stable South Caucasus, which the EU supports, reads the statement of the Council.
