KAZAKHSTAN WILL NOT BE USED BY RUSSIA FOR BYPASSING SANCTIONS - FOREIGN MINISTRY OF KAZAKHSTAN ABOUT "TRIPLE GAS UNION"

AKIPRESS (30 November 2022)
President Kassym-Joomart Tokayev will carefully review the idea of III "triple gas union" between Kazakhstan, Russia and Uzbekistan, which was proposed during the talks in Kremlin. The decision on the actual creation of a union has not yet been made, Deputy Foreign Minister of Kazakhstan Roman Vasilenko said.
The diplomat noted that the establishment of a "gas union" with Russia should not create any difficulties for Kazakhstan and let the country directly or indirectly take part in bypassing anti-Russian sanctions related to the Russian-Ukrainian conflict.
"Kazakhstan does not allow its territory to be used to circumvent sanctions. We created a commission in the government, which prevents the negative impact of the situation on the economy of Kazakhstan," Roman Vasilenko emphasized.
