THAILAND DISSOLVES PARLIAMENT FOR MAY NATIONAL ELECTION

The election would be the second since the 2014 coup and the first since youth-led pro-democracy protests rocked Bangkok in 2020.

Thailands King Maha Vajiralongkorn has endorsed a decree to dissolve parliament, according to an announcement in the Royal Gazette, paving the way for elections in May.

An election must be held 45 to 60 days after the house dissolution, which takes effect immediately.
