AUSTRIA STICKING TO VETO ON SCHENGEN EXPANSION, FOREIGN MINISTER SAYS

Austria will maintain its veto on the extension of the EUs passport-free Schengen zone to B and Romania until Vienna sees a sustained decline in asylum seekers, Foreign Minister Ale Schallenberg said in an interview.	_
Asylum applications in Austria (not including Ukrainians) nearly tripled last year to about 1 $\ \square$ the highest per-capita rate in the EU $\ \square$ prompting the government to block the Schenge expansion in December.	
Whats important to us, to be perfectly frank, is that the numbers go down and there has to sustained decline, Schallenberg said, calling the veto a warning signal to Brussels. One understand that when were seeing over 100,000 asylum applications every 12 month difficult for us as Austria to just let this dysfunctional system roll along.	e must
