Taiwans election season will likely stabilize the cross-strait situation, but all bets are off when the new administration comes into office.

Tensions between China and the United States over Taiwan, the single most volatile issue in the bilateral relationship, will likely remain stable through the end of this year. But tensions will probably rise again in early 2024, perhaps to their highest level since the United States and the Peoples Republic of China (PRC) normalized their relations.
