"AVIMs Note: The Head of the Division for Central Asia in the European Union External Action Service has unfortunately made irrational evaluations regarding Türkiye and the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus. If the EU is genuinely interested in opening to Central Asia, it should consider what is beneficial for all interested parties and keep in mind that attempting to exclude Türkiye from Central Asia will result in the EU losing influence and thus prevent it from playing an effective role in this region."

An official from the EUs diplomatic service warned on Wednesday (20 September) that Central Asian countries would face negative effects if they ratify the accession of North Cyprus as an observer to the Organisation of Turkic States (OTS).
