ARMENIAN, AZERBAIJANI OFFICIALS MEET FOR BORDER DELIMITATION TALKS

Senior Armenian and Azerbaijani officials held on Thursday another round of direct negotiations on the delimitation of the Armenian-Azerbaijani border, a key hurdle to a comprehensive peace deal between the two nations.

The fifth joint session of Armenian and Azerbaijani government commissions on border demarcation and delimitation took place at a relatively peaceful section of the heavily militarized frontier. It was co-chaired by Deputy Prime Minister Mher Grigoryan and his Azerbaijani counterpart Shahin Mustfayev.

The Armenian Foreign Ministry said that the commissions headed by the two men continued to discuss a number of organizational and procedural issues and agreed to step up their joint work. It did not report progress on substantive issues, notably the mechanism for border delimitation.
