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## **BULGARIA IN 2024: DEEPENING POLARISATION AND QUESTIONABLE STABILITY**

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The first months of 2024 will be a major test for Bulgarias fragile political stability after a two-year stalemate. Bulgaria started 2023 with little faith that the near-continuous cycle of elections would be put on hold. But the year ends with a pro-West coalition in power, even if brittle, and treated with scepticism by much of society.
Crucial year for ready-made govt
Following tense coalition talks, in June the current government took power, consisting of two opposing blocs   both previously adamant they wouldnt work together. On one side is the reformist duo of We Continue the Change and Democratic Bulgaria and on the other  their rivals from GERB and United Democratic Forces, associated with the antics of GERB leader and former PM Boyko Borissov who left a legacy of allegations of widespread corruption.
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
