
YEREVAN AGAIN LAMENTS 'REGRESSION' IN BAKU'S STANCE

Azerbaijan has reversed in recent weeks progress made in peace talks with Armenia, Foreign Minister Ararat Mirzoyan insisted on Tuesday.

Unfortunately, after this positive step of December 8 [prisoner exchange] we saw that Azerbaijan is not continuing with its constructive stance, to say the least, he told a news conference. That manifested itself through both the 7th Azerbaijani proposals on the [Armenian-Azerbaijani peace] treaty and the Azerbaijani presidents latest interview. There was a significant regression and even a blow to the peace process on a number of key issues.

Mirzoyan complained on January 10 about some regression in the latest Azerbaijani proposals on the peace treaty submitted to Yerevan. He said Baku is reluctant to explicitly recognize Armenias borders through that accord.
