
BULGARIA, ROMANIA, GREECE 'MINI SCHENGEN' WOULD BE ILLEGAL, SAYS DENKOV

Removing borders between the three nations would go against EU legislation, and their governments have no intention of starting official discussions of a zone without border control because it would be illegal, said Bulgarian Prime Minister Nikolai Denkov on Thursday.

Denkov explained that Bulgaria will seek full acceptance into Schengen according to the official procedure.

He explicitly mentioned that the Bulgarian government is supported by Germany and added that Sofia wants Berlins support to achieve full membership in Schengen and the Eurozone by the end of this year and is not seeking to create a separate border-free zone with Romania and Greece.
