JAPAN VOWS SUPPORT TO UKRAINE WHILE HOSTING CONFERENCE FOCUSED ON WARTORN COUNTRY'S RECONSTRUCTION

Japanese Prime Minister Fumio Kishida has pledged Monday his countrys long-term commitment to Ukraines reconstruction, calling it a future investment, while stressing support for the war-torn country about to mark the second anniversary of Russias invasion.

In his keynote speech at The Japan-Ukraine Conference for Promotion of Economic Growth and Reconstruction, Kishida said Japanese public and private cooperation will be a long-term partnership based on inclusivity, humanitarianism as well as technology and knowledge.

Ukraines Prime Minister Denys Shmyhal, who led his countrys delegation of more than 100 people, thanked Kishida and said that today is the new start of cooperation between the two countries.
