Kazakh Deputy Foreign Minister Alibek Kuantyrov discussed expanding strategic cooperation with the United States, particularly in trade, economic, and investment sectors at an Oct. 9 meeting with the U.S. Trade Mission delegation led by Deputy Assistant Secretary of State for Europe and Eurasia David De Falco and U.S. Ambassador to Kazakhstan Daniel Rosenblum.

In a press statement released by the Kazakh Foreign Ministry, Kuantyrov determined the U.S. House of Representatives as a key partner in maintaining constant dialogue, noting Kazakhstans positive dynamics in all major indicators of economic development despite the difficult geopolitical situation.

We are the largest economy in Central Asia, accounting for more than 60% of the regions GDP. Our country aims to remain a stable and safe place to attract foreign investment.
