KAZAKHSTAN SIGNS \$2.5 BILLION IN DEALS WITH CHINA DURING PM'S SHANGHAI VISIT

Kazakhstan signed eight commercial agreements worth \$2.5 billion with Chinese companies during Kazakh Prime Minister Olzhas Bektenovs working visit to Shanghai on Nov. 4, reported the Prime Ministers press service.

Bektenov took part in the Kazakh-Chinese investment roundtable and met with representatives of leading Chinese companies in metallurgy, energy, machinery, automotive, carbon chemistry, agribusiness, and pharmaceuticals.

The primary purpose of the visit was to implement the agreements reached between the President of Kazakhstan Kassym-Jomart Tokayev and President of China Xi Jinping to double the volume of bilateral trade turnover from last years historical record of \$41 billion.
