## EU AMBASSADORS APPROVE EXTENSION OF BORDER MONITORING MISSION IN ARMENIA

Representatives of the European Union member states approved on Wednesday a proposal to extend the EUs monitoring mission along Armenias border with Azerbaijan by two years.

The proposal was recently made by the EUs foreign policy chief, Kaja Kallas. A spokeswoman for Kallas told RFE/RLs Armenian Service on January 10 that the member states have already welcomed it. She said the extension of the mission will be formalized and announced in the coming weeks.

RFE/RL Europe Editor Rikard Jozwiak reported that the Brussels-based ambassadors of the 27 EU nations, who endorsed Kallass proposal, also decided to keep the missions mandate and size unchanged. It will thus continue to comprise 165 international observers and analysts as well as 44 Armenian staffers.
