Kazakh President Kassym-Jomart Tokayev met with Georgian Prime Minister Irakli Kobakhidze on Feb. 6 to discuss strengthening political, economic and regional cooperation, with a focus on boosting trade, infrastructure and collaboration on multilateral platforms.

During the talks, the two leaders discussed ways to deepen bilateral ties across various sectors, including trade, energy, investment, tourism, artificial intelligence and digitalization. They also addressed pressing international issues and regional security, according to the Akorda.

Special attention was given to increasing the volume of cargo traffic along the Trans-Caspian International Transport Route and modernizing the corridors transit infrastructure.
