EU EYES UKRAINE GAS STORAGE WITH TÜRKİYE AND GREECE IMPORTS TO EASE SLOVAKIA DISPUTE

The European Commission is reportedly evaluating a proposal to use Ukraines underground gas storage facilities to import gas from Türkiye and Greece, aiming to resolve tensions with Slovakia and reduce dependency on Russian energy, according to EU and government sources familiar with the discussions speaking to Politico.

The plan, initially discussed during a European Commission visit to Kyiv last month, could reestablish Slovakia as a key transit country and help mitigate its loss of revenue following the end of a long-standing gas transit agreement between Ukraine and Russia.
