New Zealand and Australia said on April 10 they are each working with other nations on a possible joint response to shore up free trade against a barrage of US tariffs.

Prime Minister Christopher Luxon of New Zealand said he had spoken with the leaders of Singapore, Vietnam and Malaysia, as well as the head of the European Unions executive about international trade cooperation.

In a speech on April 10, he said one idea was for members of the European Union and the Comprehensive and Progressive Agreement for Trans-Pacific Partnership (CPTPP) to work together.
