FIRST 'CENTRAL ASIA-ITALY' SUMMIT YIELDS JOINT DECLARATION ON REGIONAL COOPERATION

On May 30, the first Central Asia [[[[[]]]]] summit was held in Astana, Kazakhstan, where a Joint Declaration was adopted. The full text of the document was published on the official Akorda website.
According to the document, the leaders noted the progress achieved since the third Central Asia IIIII Ministerial Conference in Rome in 2024 and reaffirmed their commitment to strengthening a partnership based on shared values, mutual respect, and common interests. It was highlighted that bilateral cooperation between Central Asian countries and Italy, along with interactions within the European Parliament and other multilateral platforms, is expanding.
The head of the Italian government expressed support for the efforts of Central Asian countries to deepen regional cooperation. In this context, it was noted that consultative meetings of Central Asian heads of state play a vital role in promoting regional collaboration, multilateralism, peace and stability, sustainable development, and addressing common challenges.
