## TURKIC STATES CUSTOMS HEADS BACK MIDDLE CORRIDOR DEVELOPMENT AT TURKESTAN MEETING

*The 11th meeting of the heads of customs administrations of the member countries of the Organization of Turkic States, held in Turkestan from September 6 to 8, placed strong emphasis on the transformation of the Middle Corridor into a reliable bridge between East and West, Trend reports via the State Revenue Committee of the Ministry of Finance of the Republic of Kazakhstan.*

The heads of customs administrations of Azerbaijan, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Türkiye and Uzbekistan participated in the meeting. Observers from Hungary, Georgia, and Turkmenistan also took part in the gathering.

Kazakhstans State Revenue Committee Chairman Zhandos Duisembiev highlighted that the development of digital tools, simplification of customs procedures, and strengthening of trust are key to unlocking the Corridors potential. He pointed to initiatives such as the Technical Conditions for Information Exchange, the Single Window system, and the Institute of Authorized Economic Operators as practical steps to accelerate trade flows and improve supply chain resilience.
