The Georgian Parliament has strongly criticised a resolution adopted at the recent Euronest Parliamentary Assembly session in Yerevan, calling it anti-Georgian and accusing Armenian lawmakers of undermining Georgias government.

Georgias Deputy Parliamentary Speaker Nino Tsilosani, from the ruling Georgian Dream party, said Armenian MPs had effectively gone against their own prime minister by supporting the resolution, which questioned the legitimacy of Georgias leadership and elections.

By supporting such a resolution, they are showing a lack of trust in their own prime minister, Tsilosani said, describing the document as meaningless and designed to harm Georgia.
