The far right last week broke through the firewall in the European Parliament and is now looking to flex its muscles again to secure a wider set of goals.
Next on the target list: Deporting more migrants, reversing a ban on the combustion engine, nev rules on gene-edited crops, and even more red tape reductions for businesses.
After decades of being sidelined by mainstream political parties, the far right scored a majo victory last week when the center-right European Peoples Party (EPP) ditched its traditional centrist allies and pressed ahead with plans to cut green rules for businesses that received the backing of lawmakers on the right.
