
THOUSANDS MARCH IN PHILIPPINES, DEMANDING MARCOS RESIGN OVER FRAUD SCANDAL

Tens of thousands of people have marched in the Philippine capital, Manila, demanding President Ferdinand Marcos Jr's resignation over a corruption scandal linked to government spending on flood-control infrastructure.

The rally, organised by the Kilusang Bayan Kontra-Kurakot or the Peoples Movement Against Corruption (KBKK), began at the Luneta National Park in Manila on Sunday, with protesters marching on to the presidential palace.

Some carried an effigy of Marcos and Vice President Sara Duterte, depicting the politicians as crocodiles and dubbed the corrupt-codile, while others held signs that read Marcos Resign and All corrupt politicians must be held accountable.
