EU COMMISSION UNVEILS €165B LOAN TO UKRAINE USING RUSSIAN FROZEN ASSETS

The European Commission is proposing a reparations loan of billion for Ukraine using the cash value of frozen Russian state assets held in Belgium, according to documents obtained by POLITICO.
The reparations loan is part of a wider financial package, worth up to billion, to keep Kyiv's finances afloat for the coming years.
The IIII billion reparations loan includes IIII billion of immobilized Russian state assets held in private bank accounts across the bloc, in addition to IIIII billion held in the Euroclear bank in Belgium. Ukraine's war chest is set to run bare in April.
