Kazakhstan and Armenia are stepping up efforts to strengthen bilateral ties, with a focus on expanding trade, enhancing transport and transit connectivity, as Foreign Minister Yermek Kosherbayev met with Armenian Prime Minister Nikol Pashinyan and President Vahagn Khachaturyan in Yerevan on April 9.
