
EU REVIEWS KOSOVO REFORMS BUT WARNS DELAYS RISK OVERSHADOWING PROGRESS

Kosovo and the European Union held their seventh Stabilisation and Association Committee meeting in Pristina on Tuesday to review political developments and progress on reforms linked to Kosovos EU-related commitments.

The meeting was opened by Kosovos Chief Negotiator with the EU, Jeton Zulfaj, and Valentina Superti, Director for the Western Balkans (*) in the European Commissions Directorate-General for Enlargement and Eastern Neighbourhood (DG ENEST), the European External Action Service (EEAS) announced.

It was co-chaired by Arben Krasniqi, General Secretary at Kosovos Office of the Prime Minister, and Jiri Plecity, head of the DG ENEST unit responsible for Kosovo.
