
CEUTA'S MIGRATION CRISIS IS BECOMING A GIFT TO SPAIN'S (AND EUROPE'S) FAR-RIGHT

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This week, Ceutas president Juan Jesús Vivas spent 48 hours in Brussels because the national government [in Madrid] has failed to live up to what was required of it, he told the press at the European Parliament.

The leader of Spains north African enclave, a member of the dominant EU Parliament centre-right European Peoples party (EPP), hasnt skipped any chance to remind the public of Madrids mishandling of Ceutas mass-migration emergency.

While over 80,000 people arrived on the shores of the small autonomous city on 30 and 31 July 2026, Sanchezs government tried to cope with such copious arrivals with extra funding, reinforced border patrolling and surveillance technology, as well as with discussions on relocations in the country and housing for minors.

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
