KYRGYZSTAN RECORDS \$2.55BN IN CROSS-BORDER MONEY TRANSFERS IN 2024, WITH RUSSIA LEADING CONTRIBUTIONS

The total volume of cross-border money transfers from individuals to Kyrgyzstan reached \$2.55br by the end of 2024, reflecting a slight increase from \$2.51bn in 2023, according to 24.kg citing the National Bank of Kyrgyzstan.
The majority of incoming remittances [[[]]][[]] from CIS countries, with Russia being the eading contributor at \$2.32bn.
Fransfers from non-CIS countries amounted to \$189.7mn, with the largest contributions originating from the United States (\$54.9mn), South Korea (\$60.1mn), and Turkey (\$17.5mn).
