## CSTO MEMBER ARMENIA INKS DEFENSE AGREEMENT WITH NATO COUNTRY POLAND

*A military-technical cooperation agreement has been signed between Armenia and Poland as part of the official visit of a delegation led by Armenian Prime Minister Nikol Pashinyan to Warsaw.*

According to Armenian media, the document was signed by Armenias Foreign Minister Ararat Mirzoyan and Polands Minister of National Defence Władysław Kosiniak-Kamysz, News.az reports, citing BBC.

Poland has been a member of NATO since 1999 and actively participates in the alliances collective defense and military-technical cooperation initiatives. Armenia, in turn, is a member of the Collective Security Treaty Organization (CSTO), a military-political alliance uniting several post-Soviet countries.
